7. Supplement to observations:

Crews report camouflage of MARIBOR Engineering & Assembly Shops to be exceptionally well done. Two groves of trees to the N.W. of shops are extended across roofs of building by means of camouflage making the target difficult to see. Note Photo 5127, Report No. H-3, H.A.P.R.W.

Approximately $\frac{1}{2}$ to $\frac{3}{4}$ mile south of Island West of MARIBOR, 46°34'N, 15°37'E, a flat top hill is very pronounced. Hill looks to be tree covered, but at one corner some was visible escaping from beneath surface. It is belief of crews that underground installations are present.
