NARRATIVE MISSION REPORT Covering: MISSION OF 24 MAY 1943

- 1. 26 B-17's of the 32nd, 352nd, 353rd, 419th Squadrons, 301st Bomb Group took off at 1200 "B" to bomb TERRANOVA PAUSANIA (OLBIA), Sardinia. 2 of our a/c returned early because of mechanical trouble. 24 a/c were over the target at 1453 "B" and dropped 288 x 500 GP (.1 nose, .025 tail fusing) from a mean altitude of 24,750 ft. at a heading of 92 M. 24 x 500 GP bombs were returned to base and none were jettisioned. None of our personnel were injured and no planes were damaged. All planes were safely down at 1753 "B".
- 2. 1 M/V at R/28 (Target Chart O/4(2)) received direct hits and was reported on fire. 1 M/V at P/34 hit and exploded. Near misses and possible hits on M/V at N/36. Several hits and many near misses on M/V at H-I/36. Many direct hits along the outer end of quay with a large explosion reported at P/18.
- 3. Slight heavy inaccurate flak encountered in target area. Flak positions were reported at P/5, P-0/9, 8 guns at Q/10-11-12-13 (Target Chart 1-105A-NA).
- 4. No e/a were encountered.
- 3 of our a/c attempted photos and usual report will follow.
- 6. Weather was slight hazy enroute; CAVU over target.
- 7. 1 medium M/V reported moving SW, speed unknown, at 41°45'Nx08°42"E, just off CASTEL SARDO, while flying at 25,000 ft.
