SECTION I - AWARDS OF THE BRONZE STAR MEDAL

Under the provisions of AF 600-45, as amended, and pursuant to authority contained in Circular No. 89, NATOU5A, 10 July 1944, the Bronze Star Medal is awarded the following named enlisted men:
