It seems that I finally got some place. We are now in Italy but we spent a few days in Africa. I haven't been able to find out yet but I think Ralph is stationed around here somewhere and if he is I will be able to see him.

We are supposed to complete fifty missions before we can go back to the states for a furlough and so far I have flown two missions. Things are still pretty well torn up around here and there isn't much to do. We have shows and the Red Cross has some places fixed up pretty nice.
