I. ENEMY RESISTANCE

- A. Fighters: Six (6) ME-109's observed at 46°46' N, 12°51' E, at 1345 hours, at 14,000 feet. These planes circled the formation and then headed off at 200°. Four (4) FW-190's seen at 47°00' N, 12°00' E, at 15,000 feet. Four (4) unidentified enemy fighters were observed at 48°10' N, 13°55' E, at 1238 hours.
- B. Flak: Moderate, accurate heavy flak was encountered at the target area.
