 MISSION: 8 February 1945.

Vienna South East Goods Section, Austria.

I. ENEMY RESISTANCE

- A. Three (3) unidentified single engine aircraft were observed but not encountered at Zagreb, at 1328 hours, at 2,000 feet.  
 B. Flak: Flak at target was moderate, accurate of the track type.

II. SIGNIFICANT OBSERVATIONS

- A. Communications: M/Y at Varizdain is one-quarter full. Activity was observed at Graz M/Y. M/Y at Urbanovec, 46°16'N-16°31'E, was active.  
 B. Flak Positions: Slight, inaccurate flak of the barrage type was encountered at 46°18'N-16°30'E. At Varazdin, flak was slight, inaccurate, of the barrage type. Slight, accurate flak of the track type was observed at Maribor. At Nagykanzia, flak was slight, inaccurate of the track type.  
 C. Smoke screen: Smoke screen observed at Graz.  
 D. Naval: Negative.  
 E. Airdromes: Negative.
